Courtney was led to Christ by Sister Teri, her S.S. teacher. Elizabeth and Emily were led to The Lord by Krystal, one of our youth workers! I lead Ray to The Lord in the hospital. Mike was saved in our home Thursday night. Pete was saved at the church while pulling weeds. Sabrina and Makala were saved in my office on Wednesday night after the youth class. There were 5 saved at "Stop the Violence". Praise The Lord, for these precious souls and soul winners!

Baptisms! We baptized 3 this month! Mike and Nita. They are husband and wife. Mike is retired from the Navy. We were also blessed to baptize Courtney. We praise The Lord for these three additions.

Mail Outs We have started a mail-out, out-reach. We have mailed out 1,850 pieces this month. This consists of a tract, letter and a real nice directional card, telling how to get to the church. We have already had two responses. Now when we knock their door they will have already heard from us.

Daycare! Our director, Rachel Budd, has finished her classes. The state will now appoint us a case worker that will tell us what we need to do to our facilities to get ready. We are looking forward to getting this off the ground.

We Really Need Your Help Folks! We owe over \$519,000.00 Dollars on our building. We have a real nice building that can seat over 300 people. It was built by the Macedonia builders. The Lord is also growing the work here! There have been over 430 souls saved in the last year with all the ministries we have been involved in! We have baptized 25 saints, in one year! What a great place to establish a soul winning church for Our Lord! You can be a big part of that. Would you please consider helping us to pay down some of this debt? We are paying over \$3,500.00 interest per month. If you could please consider sending us a onetime offering, that would be great! There are thousands of souls here that need The Lord and God has opened the door for us. There is some great response, to The Word of God, in Henderson and Las Vegas!
